Measures adopted by Copag:



Cancellation of face-to-face meetings, trips, training, and construction work.



Quarantine at home office for those who returned from vacation travel.



Restriction of and control over visitors.



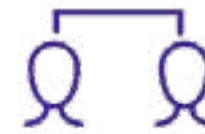
Risk group released from work.



Home office for entire administrative staff.



Communication plan to pass clear and objective information.



Compartmentalization of employees and sectors to avoid shutdown.



Daily monitoring of all positive and suspected cases of Covid-19 infection.



Crisis Management Committee created.



Creation of a testing protocol for essential visits and employees.



Release of chairs for employees at home office.



Increase in cleaning frequency for all areas.



Gradual plan to return to face-to-face work (voluntary).

Measures implemented at the factory:



Safety signs and demarcation of social distance.



Social distance of at least 1.5m everywhere.



Suspension of direct contact among people.



Guidance on hand hygiene with water, soap and 70% alcohol gel.



Daily body temperature verification.

Delivery of black, red, blue, and white masks to be changed after 3 hours of use.



Identification of number of people per room.



Installation of acrylic displays to allow safe communication in People and Management, Financial and Cafeteria areas.



Visual signage to instruct on Covid-19 care.



The following precautions were adopted in our cafeteria:

- Utensils and dishes were sterilized and packaged for use;
- Cabins with acrylic dividers on tables;
- Distance marks for serving;
- Mealtimes established per sector to avoid crowding;
- Creation of a space outside the cafeteria for meals.



Covid-19



Before allowing entry into the factory, we carry out a quick test on:

- 100% of essential visitors;
- 100% of employees returning from vacation;
- 100% of employees that traveled by air or river transportation after a minimum isolation period of 14 days.

Tests are applied by Copag's outpatient team. In case of positive result, we refer the person to a new test in an off-site laboratory (quantitative serology) for retest and quantitative analysis of IgG and IgM. This way, only individuals who tested negative are released to access the plant.

The journey is not over yet, Crisis Management Committee is working on a day-by-day basis to mitigate risk of contagion among people. Since the beginning of the pandemic, we have shared guidelines and preventive measures in accordance with Ministry of Health recommendations to ensure our employees, service providers, family members and society's health and safety.

Protect yourself:

Avoid crowds and keep distance of at least 1.5 m from other people if you need to leave home. Care for your body and mind: balanced eating, drinking lots of water, having a good night's sleep and

staying connected with people are practices that can help.

Do not share personal items (cutlery, plates, glasses, bottles, etc.) and clean objects and surfaces that are frequently touched.

Do not leave alcohol gel inside the car to avoid accidents.

Wash your hands frequently and avoid touching your face. Whenever possible, use alcohol gel to ensure that they are properly sterilized.

Wear a mask whenever you leave home.

Cover your nose and mouth when you sneeze or cough and clean your hands afterwards.
